

# SOUTH CANAL BLVD. IMPROVEMENTS



## **Project Overview**

The City of Redmond is upgrading South Canal Blvd. to meet current standards for arterials. This long-awaited project replaces deteriorating pavement on a major route that is an important part of the city's street network.

The South Canal Blvd. "makeover" also includes:

- Left turn lanes at busy intersections
- Curbs, sidewalks and bicycle lanes
- Stormwater collection system
- A new bicycle/pedestrian path alongside Homestead Canal
- Street trees and landscaping
- A new 12- and 18-inch water main to replace aging pipelines

# **South Canal Blvd. Improvements**

Cost: \$6.9 million

**Funding**: City of Redmond Transportation and Water Funds

Contractor: Knife River Northwest

Construction Start: March 2018

Completion: April 2019

South Canal Blvd. Improvements is a partnership project of the City of Redmond and Knife River Northwest.

### **Traffic Detours During Construction**

Rebuilding the street will take 13 months, with project completion set for April 2019. Sections of South Canal Blvd. will be closed temporarily during construction, but *local access to area homes and businesses will remain open*.

Traffic detour routes are shown on the accompanying map and will be updated throughout the project.
